For an emergency bee sting kit, what would it contain?
-APAP, epinephrine, topical benadryl (would you really need APAP immediately?) All of the above; APAP for pain.

Is there a specific algorithm for sepsis treatment? Depends on many factors. I would look in a textbook of medicine.

Which antiretroviral do you d/c when CD4<175? I cannot find a definitive answer. Perhaps all of them since this would be indication of treatment failure. You might continue only NRTIs at that level. Would this be Zithromax since they wouldn't need coverage for MAC? No, because Z'max is not an antiretroviral.

If a baby is lactose intolerant, what would you give?
Wouldn't you give Lactaid milk since the baby obviously cant swallow/chew lactaid tablets. YES unless there are other choices such as soy based formulas (ProSobee).

Exactly which antibiotic suspensions HAVE to be refrigerated? I know Augmentin, but is there more? Most must be. The shorted list is the ones that are NOT refrigerated. I would have to walk through a pharmacy and read labels.

Would the best treatment for diaper rash be nystatin/triam.? Other options are Hydrocortisone, miconazole, ketoconazole, methylprednisolon -- off that list yes nys/triam.

Lastly, I mostly worried about the GA boards...the compounding lab. I have already went through your entire calculations packet, but I was wondering if the math problems in the lab were more like that packet? Or are they similar to the two in your compounding lab section? More like in the compounding handout.
