Mike:

I do a "flat rate" and you can charge students or others as you like. My fee is \$1000 a day (\$2000 for 2 days) plus travel and I would probably try to make you and Florida A&M back to back to reduce that cost to both schools. I need two full days (9 to 5) to be sure to cover everything.

Some schools get a chain to sponsor at least part of the event. It helps if lunch is part of the program to reduce the time lost for everyone leaving the area, but that is a local issue.

I provide a master CD-ROM and a couple of master paper handouts to the school (one is the test) and you duplicate those at your cost. That is cheaper than me having to do them commercial and pass the cost along.

You can videotape or do distance learning live (Florida A&M does that).

What gets covered? Calculations, Pharmaceutics with pharmacokinetics, compounding for NAPLEX, reviews of herbs, anemias, various diseases, how to prepare and take the test, other study materials that are available and files of material from students who took the test in the past. I also cover signing up for the test and getting licenses in other states.

I have retired from UGA (get to keep the phone number and e-mail) and so have greater flexibility in scheduling. Let me know if you need anything else.

Our graduation is currently set for May 9, 2007. We are looking to set up a 2-3 day review session, preferably, for May 5-7.

I would only need 2 days. I also do Hampton and Appalachia and so would like to make your review contingent to one, or both, of those to save some driving. Having the preceeding weekend as an option is good.

What is your rate for a review? The review would be for 55-65 students. I charge a flat \$2000 for the review plus travel expenses. If I can match a couple of reviews together, that saves everyone money.

You can charge anyone who attends as you see fit. In addition, I provide a master CD-ROM and a master printed document of about 75 pages that must be printed for use during the review. I have found it better if the school does its own duplication rather than reimburse me for the cost of having it done commercially.

I am going to be starting to make some preliminary dates with existing schools and work out a schedule. Since I have retired, I have greater flexibility than was available last year.
