**PLAINTIFF'S APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND
MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

Pursuant to the provisions of Fed. R. Civ. P. 65, Plaintiff National Association of Boards of Pharmacy ("NABP") hereby applies to the Court for a Temporary Restraining Order and, prior to the expiration thereof, moves the Court for a Preliminary Injunction both enjoining and restraining Defendants from distributing any of NABP's copyrighted examination questions; from otherwise infringing NABP's copyrights; from benefiting from their misuse, misappropriation, pirating and theft of the copyrights of NABP in its examination questions; and surrendering up for impounding by the United States Marshall all documents, handouts, disks, CD-ROMs, computers, e-mails, web-postings, slide shows, books, advertisements, programs, or similar material containing NABP's copyrighted examination questions; all on the grounds that the extent of damages to NABP as a result of the aforesaid wrongful conduct by Defendants cannot be determined, that NABP does not have an adequate remedy at law and that if


Defendants are not enjoined and restrained as moved, NABP will be immediately, substantially, continuously, and irreparably injured and harmed.

WHEREFORE, NABP prays that its Application for a Temporary Restraining Order be granted, that its Motion for a Preliminary Injunction be set for hearing prior to the expiration of said Temporary Restraining Order, and that said Motion for a Preliminary Injunction be granted as moved.
