PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR EXPEDITED, LIMITED DISCOVERY

Pursuant to Rules 26(d), 30(a), 33, 34(b), and 36 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Plaintiff National Association of Boards of Pharmacy ("NABP") hereby moves the Court to permit limited, expedited discovery in aid of Plaintiff's Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, filed on August 3, 2007, as follows:

1. NABP seeks leave of Court to immediately serve requests for production of documents, interrogatories, and requests to admit upon Defendants Flynn Warren, Jr., ("Defendant Warren") and Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, ("Defendant UGA"). Copies of NABP's proposed requests and interrogatories are attached hereto as Exhibits A, B, C, E, and F respectively.

2. NABP seeks an Order requiring Defendants Warren and UGA to produce the requested documents and respond to the interrogatories and requests to admit within fourteen calendar days of service of the document requests and interrogatories or such other period

ordered by the Court as will permit NABP to prepare for a hearing on its Motion for a Preliminary Injunction.

3. NABP seeks leave of Court to conduct a four-hour deposition of Defendants Warren and UGA within seven days after NABP has received the documents responsive to the requests. A copy of the proposed Notices of Deposition are attached hereto as Exhibits D and G. NABP wishes to reserve its right to re-depose Defendants during the case-in-chief.


In support of its Motion for Limited, Expedited Discovery, NABP relies on the Verified Complaint and the Declarations of Walter Steven Pray, Alan Ray Spies, Kerri A. Hochgesang, and Carmen Catizone, which were submitted in support of Plaintiff's Application for a Temporary Restraining Order and Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, and on the attached Memorandum of Law in Support of this Motion.

WHEREFORE, NABP respectfully requests that the Court GRANT its Motion for Limited, Expedited Discovery. For the Court's convenience, a proposed Order granting the Motion is submitted herewith.
